Steps to Learning:

Second grade:

Students check in their books then come to the rug. Check roll (list on cart)
 Review procedures for check in/out, centers, free flow, care of books.

There are three main areas in our library that we check out books. Can you name them? Easy (picture books), Fiction (chapter books) and Non-fiction
 Read: **Mr. Wiggle Loves to Read** then go to the computer area and talk about the 3 anchor charts. Go back to rug.

Online safety: What does it mean to be safe online? How can you protect yourself online?

Kindergarten:

Students check in their books then come to the rug (still need help checking in) Check attendance (List on cart)

Review procedures for check in/out, centers, free flow, care of books

Read: **Manners in the Library** and **We're Going on a Book Hunt**

What does online safety mean? Can you go on the Internet and look at anything you want? How do you know if you are not supposed to be on that website?

Sub directions:

Second Grade: Read: **Mr. Wiggles Loves to Read** and **Wild about Books**

Kindergarten: Read **We're Going on a Book Hunt** and **Manners in the Library** then have students check out books. After everyone has checked out, have students leave books where they were sitting and come back to rug to listen to you read **Wild about Books**. After the story, students may return to where their books are and stay until time to line up.
