- ✓ Read: The Christmas Coat and Blackout

Fourth Grade:

- ✓ Introduce the Caldecott award. Use power point with facts and the criteria for a book to win the Caldecott?
- ✓ How would a book win the Arkansas Diamond award? Must be on the list; has the most votes from the children of Arkansas K-3
- ✓ Review research skills then read "Just the Facts"
- ✓ Read chapters 1 & 2 from Sideway Stories from Wayside School
