Dear Parent,

Reading is an important part of the success of a child at school and in the world. Reading with your child builds a wonderful relationship between parent and child. Today your child will receive a “Reading Will Take You Places” reading log. The reading log is for your child to write down the name of each book after it has been read. An adult needs to sign their name after the title of the book. When your child completes the log, he/she will bring the reading log to the library for a prize. Students may read books from our school library, Faulkner County library, books from home or books in their classroom (where ever they find books). This reading program will be from October 1, 2014-April 30, 2015.

Kindergarten students will have books read to them so you will want to keep the reading log at home to fill out.

First grade students may read some books on their own and have some books read to them. You may want to leave the log in their daily folder.

Second grade through fourth grade students should read books on their own. These students may read to younger kids at home or if they have book buddies at school they may read easier books. Please mark on the log why they are reading easy books so we will know. You may want to leave the log in their daily folder.
